Patrol News & Notes

As we enter the spring and summer months it is great to see everyone outside exercising, working in the yard, and enjoying the park. The Patrol has been busy helping keep crime low in the neighborhood. Please keep in mind that as we become more active outside so do the criminals. Here are a few tips to help keep you and your property safe.

- 1) If you see suspicious activity or a crime in progress dial 911, then feel free to post the incident on social media sites.
- 2) Keep windows and doors closed and locked, especially at night.
- 3) Document model and serial numbers for your electronic devices.
- 4) Ensure that your home Wi-Fi is secure.
- 5) Change the batteries in your smoke alarms.
- 6) Have an escape plan in case of fire or other emergencies.
- 7) Thefts of weed eaters, blowers, and other lawn equipment will be on the increase. Help keep an eye on our neighbors and lawn care professionals equipment.
- 8) Secure your valuables. Hiding them is not a good way to secure them.
- 9) Think about investing in a fire proof safe. Or keep your valuables in a safety deposit box.
- Do not advertise your vacations or trips on social media.
- 11) Meeting someone for an internet sale or purchase is dangerous. It is recommended that you meet at a local police station to complete the transaction.

Kappa Sigma Emory brought a strong group on Mar.24th to plant some 80 trees and shrubs donated by Park Pride in the now cleared area south of the vehicular bridge. With return of spring Kittredge Park is a great place to spend an hour or more, the wild iris are especially nice along the creek next to the deck. 


CAN Civic Association Network

C.A.N. met on Jan. 24th to hear updates from our DeKalb State Delegation (Sen. Parent, and Reps. Mosby, Holcomb, Hanson). As I write on the last day of this legislative session, you should by now know which of their initiatives passed or failed to become law. Feb. 28th was devoted to the experiences of neighborhood activists Ted Daniels, Joe Arrington, and Mike Cooper working with and around DeKalb government. Mar. 28th C.A.N. heard a presentation about the workings of Magistrate Court by Chief Magistrate Berryl Anderson with Judges Holly Mannheimer (Ordinance Div.) and Rhathelia Stroud (Mental Health). Magistrate court was formed in 1983 to handle minor Civil (less than \$15,000) and Criminal cases. Since 2015 Code Enforcement cases are placed there instead of Recorders Court and emphasize compliance over penalty. Mental Health court offers judicial case management in lieu of incarceration in many instances.

? Did You Know?

The Georgia legislature approved a bill that allows local governments to use cameras to ticket drivers who speed in school zones. Cameras will be used only in jurisdictions where local governments pass ordinances that authorize them.

The Georgia legislature also passed a bill that prohibits use of hand-held devices while driving. The distracted driving bill bans more than many people may think. Next time you're with friends who are reading an email or text message while stopped at a traffic signal, let them know it's illegal. Fines for repeat offenders are steep.

Last year, DeKalb County invested nearly \$30 million for maintenance, repair and upgrades of the sewer system. The county also cleaned 220 miles of sewers, removed 5.1 tons of debris, completed 1,821 stream crossing inspections, replaced 3,000 manhole covers, held the first consent decree public update and hosted 280 other public events. The county has inspected nearly 100 percent of all the priority sewer lines and is on target to invest an additional \$79 million in improvements during the next two years.









LaVista Park / Garden Club

Well by the time you read this, the goats will have departed our park and left behind almost no ivy, weeds, privet, etc. But they did leave behind a group of very happy visitors, including some from outside LaVista Park. The 18 kids born during their month long stay captured the heart of everyone who saw them. They are just ADORABLE!!!

Yes, there was some tree damage, mostly the cherry laurel and mahonia (neither of which we wanted anyway). The magnolia bark will grow back as evidenced by what you see in the first section they cleared. As Michael told us, goats and trees have cohabited for a very long time and the trees have figured it out. The goats did break some branches and smaller tree limbs because they wanted to eat the fresh, young, tender leaves that appeared after they arrived. We will address this next year by making sure they come AND depart before any new growth begins. This was a learning year for us. Several important lessons learned that will be incorporated in the return of the goats next year (earlier!!).

We will now start on cleanup of the park – years of debris and trash dumped or blown there that has been virtually inaccessible until now. I'll be sending out a Constant Contact and NextDoor Neighbor announcement and PLEASE, if you enjoyed the goats, consider coming to help clear out branches to restore our park. It's why we had the goats here in the first place. They can only do so much. The rest is up to us.
