In addition to local developments, there are big-picture projects that will soon benefit LaVista Park residents. If

you haven't yet explored the nearby Peachtree Creek Greenway, it's a perfect fall outing. It's currently just a 10-minute drive and offers a scenic place for walking, jogging, or just enjoying the change in season.

Within the next several years, our neighborhood will have a more direct connection to the Greenway via a pedestrian bridge over I-85. The bridge will meet up with Phase II of the Greenway, now in the right-of-way acquisition phase. Phase II will extend southwest from the existing Greenway to the Fulton county line, eventually providing a connection to the Atlanta Beltline. Phase III of the Greenway, now in the preliminary design phase, will extend east to the City of Chamblee limits. Check the City of Brookhaven Public Works web page for monthly updates on these and other projects.

The **PATH Foundation** is making progress on trail connections through the Emory University area, with the long-term goal of linking our neighborhood more directly to the campus and to the South Fork of Peachtree Creek.

The Georgia Department of Transportation is slowly approaching completion of the intersection improvements at Briarcliff and LaVista Roads, which will include turn lanes and additional sidewalks. The new crossing signal at Citadel Drive is now operational! Additionally, Council Representative John Funny and DeKalb County Commissioner Michelle Spears met to develop a plan to fill the last remaining gap in the sidewalk network along Briarcliff Road. This will

provide safe walking access from cross streets in the neighborhood to MARTA bus stops, the Emory shuttle, and the new sidewalks leading to LaVista Road. Walkers, bus and shuttle commuters, shoppers, and canine companions appreciate these efforts!

Together these projects will offer new biking and walking routes that connect us to the wider city without ever needing to get in a car.

#### **Neighborhood Events/Community Spirit**

Fall is also the season for neighborhood gatherings. Keep an eye out for events hosted by the LVPCA — from block parties to beautification projects — and make time to reconnect. Whether you've lived here for two years or two decades, there's always something new to discover and someone new to meet.

# Record participation at park cleanup







Park Coordinator Lucas Curry organized a very successful workday in the Park on August 30, with 36 volunteers attending. They uprooted stilt grass and chaff flower ("the nuclear waste of the botanical world") and bagged them for landfill. LVPCA provided pizza from Eataliano kitchen afterward. Thank you, Lucas, and thanks to Eco-Addendum

and Brookhaven Park Stewards for their support and participation! Having 36 volunteers was terrific. We've had no word yet from the City on funding of improvements to park streambed and infrastructure improvements; the Master Plan was accepted by City Council in July.



Election day is November 4. Advance voting will be October 14-31. LaVista Park has multiple precincts – check the Georgia Secretary of State My Voter Page for advance voting and election day locations and for information on voting by mail. Emory University will again offer a convenient ADVANCE voting location with free parking. On election day you must vote at your precinct. This will be a municipal general election, and there is also an important Public Service Commissioner race. Sample ballots are not yet available. We'll send out more information as the time approaches.

Would you or a family member like to increase


